The June 9, 2020 Primary Election will be conducted **entirely by mail**.

We are confident that the Clerks and Registrars of Nevada will conduct a fair, transparent and accurate election as this is basically an expansion on the no-excuse, permanent mail-in voting option that is currently in place.

In the 2018 General Election, 18.37% of Douglas County voters cast their ballots via mail, **giving us the highest per capita percentage of voters that voted by mail in the State**. We currently have controls in place to manage the mail-in ballot process and are constantly reevaluating and improving upon those controls.

How do I get a mail-in (absentee) ballot?

The June 9, 2020 Primary Election will be conducted **entirely by mail**. All **active** voters will receive a ballot the first week of May, 2020. Newly registered voters, and existing voters who make updates to their voter records will be mailed ballots as they register or update, through Thursday, May 21, 2020.

The June 9, 2020, Primary Election is being conducted **entirely by mail**.

The Historic Courthouse, located at 1616 8th St., Minden, will serve as the only vote center for the June 9, 2020 Primary Election. **Vote center activities are limited to same day registration with provisional ballot voting, in-person mail-in ballot deliveries, and replacement ballot pickups.** The vote center will be open during the following dates/times and hours.
